I. SUMMARY OF JOINT RESOLUTION

This report is for House Bill No. <u>255</u> of the 2017 Regular Session by Representative <u>Gary Carter</u>, proposing to <u>amend Art. VII, Section 10.3(C)(3) and (4) and to add Article VII, Section 10.3(A)(5)</u> and (C)(5) of the Constitution.

HB 255 proposes to allow for the use of the Budget Stabilization Fund (Rainy Day Fund) for state costs associated with a federally declared disaster

II. CONCLUSION

The proposed measure cannot be accomplished statutorily.

HB 255 proposes to allow a certain percentage of the Budget Stabilization Fund to be used toward state costs following a federally declared disaster. A constitutional amendment would be required to make this change in the use of the Budget Stabilization Fund.
