EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Proposed law adds to present law the requirement of an applicant for licensure as a home inspector, submission of a criminal background check request form to the office of state police. Proposed law will shift the credit card service fee from the board to the applicant.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable SGF increase by assessing the credit card service fee to the home inspectors who utilize credit cards for certain payments to the board. LFO is not able to determine an estimated figure the proposed law will generate as the usage of a credit card is a personal prerogative.
