- 14 risk of or the expense or portion thereof for the mechanical breakdown or mechanical failure
- of a motor vehicle and may include other customer assistance and convenience services,
- such as vehicle rental assistance, towing assistance, trip interruption, and roadside assistance,
- and shall include those agreements commonly known as vehicle service agreements or
- extended warranty agreements where the assumption of risk is made by an entity other than
- 19 the owner, seller, or lessor of the vehicle."
