TAX/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE: Provides relative to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Removes reference to license taxes on all beverages of high alcoholic content handled in Louisiana from <u>present law</u>.

## Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the donation of alcoholic beverages to licensed Type A special events or unlicensed civic, religious, or charitable organizations, subject to applicable excise taxes.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to clarify that <u>present law</u> applies to beverages of high and low alcoholic content.

<u>Present law</u> imposes excise or license taxes on all beverages of high alcoholic content handled in Louisiana.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes reference to "license" taxes from <u>present law</u> and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
