1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 and 4 in their  
3 entirety and insert "amend and reenact R.S. 32:71(C), (D), and (E) and to enact R.S.  
4 32:71(F), relative to lane usage on interstate highways; to provide for penalties; and to  
5 provide for related"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, line 7, after "Section 1." and before "is" delete "R.S. 32:71(B)(3)" and insert  
8 "R.S. 32:71(C), (D), and (E) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 32:71(F)"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, delete lines 10 through 19 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

11 "C. The first violation of the provisions of Subsection A of this Section or  
12 Paragraph (B)(1) of this Section shall be punished by a fine of not more than three  
13 hundred fifty dollars or imprisonment for not more than thirty days, or both. Each  
14 subsequent violation shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand  
15 dollars or imprisonment for not more than ninety days, or both."

16 ~~€~~ D. The Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of motor  
17 vehicles, is directed to include a summary of this Section in any instructional  
18 publication for drivers.

19 ~~Đ~~ E. The Department of Transportation and Development is directed to  
20 place signs on multilane highways, in an effort to make motorists aware of the  
21 provisions provided for in this Section.

22 ~~£~~ F. The Louisiana Highway Safety Commission and the Department of  
23 Transportation and Development are directed to cooperatively develop and engage  
24 a public awareness campaign to notify motorists of the provisions of this Section."
