SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Clarifies language that the reserve or part-time peace officer's ability to carry a concealed weapon is subject to the policy and procedures of the law enforcement agency with which he is employed.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a reserve or part-time peace officer shall not be permitted to carry a concealed weapon unless he is in the actual discharge of his official duties as a reserve or part-time peace officer or he possesses a concealed handgun permit or he has been certified by the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training under the same standards as full-time officers.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes <u>present law</u> and provides that, subject to the policy and procedures of the law enforcement agency with which he is employed, a reserve or part-time peace officer may be permitted to carry a concealed weapon if he has completed the Council on Peace Officer Standards and Training basic firearms course.
