4 On page 1, at the beginning of line 8, change "Services;" to "Services; to provide housing
5 at certain residential facilities;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 Delete House Committee Amendment No. 2 by the House Committee on Administration of

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 2, delete line 4 in its entirety and insert "~~or homeless youth~~, **or sexually exploited**
11 **children, or a safe house as defined in**"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 2, line 23, after "**child**" and before "**has**" insert a comma "," and insert "**who is not**
14 **in the custody of the department,**"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 6

16 On page 4, delete line 12 in its entirety, and insert the following:

17 "for sexually exploited children are known ~~and available~~ to children who
18 have been"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 7

20 On page 5, line 3, after "**known**" and before "**to**" delete "**and available**"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 8

22 On page 5, between lines 22 and 23, insert the following:

23 "Section 2. R.S. 46:1403.1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
24 follows:

25 §1403.1. Extended stay for completion of educational courses or other programs
26 ~~A.~~ Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, including but
27 not limited to R.S. 46:1403(A)(1), a child housed at a residential home, may stay at
28 such home ~~for a period not to exceed six months beyond his eighteenth birthday to~~
29 ~~complete any educational course that he began at such facility, including but not~~

1 limited to a General Education Development course, and any other program offered
2 by the residential home.

3 ~~B. Notwithstanding Subsection A of this Section and any other provision of~~
4 ~~law to the contrary, including but not limited to R.S. 46:1403(A)(1), a child housed~~
5 ~~at a residential home that does not receive Title IV-E funding pursuant to 42 U.S.C.~~
6 ~~670 et seq., may remain at such home until his twenty-first birthday to complete any~~
7 ~~educational course that he began at such facility, including but not limited to a~~
8 ~~General Education Development course, and any other program offered by the~~
9 ~~residential home."~~

10 AMENDMENT NO. 9

11 On page 5, at the beginning of line 23, change "Section 2." to "Section 3."
