To commend certain Louisiana nursing facilities on being bestowed the prestigious American Health Care Association National Quality Bronze Award.

WHEREAS, the American Health Care Association National Quality Award Program recognizes skilled nursing facilities for quality care and performance excellence based on the nationally recognized Baldrige Performance Excellence criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality criteria was established by Congress in 1987 to enhance the competitiveness of United States businesses through promoting excellence in organizational performance, recognizing quality and performance achievements, and publishing successful performance strategies; and

WHEREAS, the Baldrige criteria is based on core values and concepts that present beliefs and behaviors found in high performing organizations including visionary leadership, patient-focused excellence, managing for innovation, ethics and transparency, valuing people, and delivering quality services and results; and

WHEREAS, trained examiners review each application relative to award criteria, accessing achievements, strengths, and opportunities for improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Bronze Commitment to Quality Award is conferred upon facilities that have shown a commitment to successful improvement as driven by their performance
