SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1, Requires that the distribution to the New Orleans Regional Black Chamber of Commerce be pursuant to a cooperative endeavor agreement between the chamber and the city of New Orleans.
- 2 Clarifies that the regional black chamber is the New Orleans Regional Black Chamber of Commerce.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

SB 252 Reengrossed

Present law requires that the automobile rental tax collected in Orleans Parish be used for road repairs and beautification projects. However, present law further provides that notwithstanding the road repairs and beautification projects requirement, the automobile rental tax collected in Orleans Parish be dedicated 25% to the Downtown Development District of New Orleans and 75% of the tax to the New Orleans Council on Aging.

Proposed law retains the present law dedication of 75% of the local automobile rental tax collected in New Orleans to the New Orleans Council on Aging.

Proposed law changes the recipient of the dedication of 25% of the local automobile rental tax from the Downtown Development District of New Orleans to the New Orleans Regional Black Chamber of Commerce. Requires that this distribution is made pursuant to a cooperative endeavor agreement between the chamber and the city of New Orleans providing that the distribution is for a public purpose and is not gratuitous and the city receives something of comparable value.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
