LOCAL OFFICIALS. EN NO IMPACT GF EX See Note Provides for the Work Out Now: WON Louisiana Legislative Commission. (gov sig)

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The proposed law establishes the Work Out Now: WON Louisiana Legislative Commission, comprised of 6 legislative members, to work directly with local officials to bring the battle against obesity to the local level. The Commission may hold public hearings as part of carrying out its duties. The chairman may call a hearing at a time and location deemed appropriate to best engage with the local elected officials. If the chairman calls a hearing in a location outside of the state capitol, a notice shall be issued to all legislators representing an area of the state in which the commission shall meet. Upon request by the chairman, the staff of the Senate Committee on Health & Welfare shall support and assist the commission. Each agency and political subdivision shall furnish aid, services, and assistance as requested by the Commission. No legislator shall receive per diem or mileage reimbursement for attending any commission meeting held when the legislature is not in session or for attending any commission meeting held at a location other than the state capitol. Unless reauthorized by the Legislature, the proposed law shall expire on 7/1/2020.
