HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

HB 234 2017 Regular Session Zeringue

CAPITAL OUTLAY: Provides relative to the local match requirements for non-state entities applying for capital outlay funding

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Delete <u>proposed law</u> repeal of the exception for non-state entity projects for which the non-state entity had demonstrated its inability to provide a local match and changes to the basis for the local match.
- 2. Remove <u>proposed law</u> authorizing the commissioner to reduce the local match requirement for non-state entity projects to not less than 10% of the total project cost if the non-state entity does meets certain requirements.
- 3. Remove <u>proposed law</u> requiring the non-state entity to execute the statement of sponsorship prior to requesting a reduction in the local match requirement from the commissioner.
- 4. Remove application of <u>proposed law</u> to the funding of all non-state entity projects included in the capital outlay budget for fiscal years commencing on and after July 1, 2017.
- 3. Add provisions for the Onmibus Bond Authorization Act of 2017 that provides for the implementation of a five-year capital improvement program.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Provides for the implementation of a five-year capital improvement program; provides for the repeal of certain prior bond authorizations; provides for new bond authorizations; provides for authorization and sale of such bonds by the State Bond Commission; and provides for related matters.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
