EN NO IMPACT See Note

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Limits the permissible uses of monies in the Saltwater Fish Research and Conservation Fund. (8/1/17)

Present law requires that the monies credited to the Saltwater Fish Research Conservation Fund, a subset of the Conservation Fund be used by the office of fisheries for data collection and management and conservation of recreational saltwater fish species. Proposed law repeals present law by further limiting use of the funds only to the administration and conducting of the Louisiana Recreational Creel Survey (LACREEL) and the Recreational Offshore Landing Permit Program (ROLP).
