AN ACT

To enact R.S. 33:381(C)(34), relative to the town of Stonewall and DeSoto Parish; to provide for the abolition of the office of police chief and the police department in the town of Stonewall; to authorize the town to contract with other law enforcement entities in the parish for law enforcement services; and to provide for related matters.

Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of Louisiana.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 33:381(C)(34) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§381. Municipal officers

* * *

(34)(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the board of aldermen of the town of Stonewall may, upon recommendation of the mayor, abolish the office of chief of police of the town. No such action by the board shall be effective until the end of the term of the police chief in office at the time of that action or when a vacancy occurs in the office, whichever occurs first; however, if at the time of that action the office is filled by an officer temporarily appointed, the abolition of the office shall become effective as provided by ordinance.

(b) If the office of chief of police is abolished and the municipal police department is abolished pursuant to R.S. 33:362(C), the mayor and board of
