**Jones** 

Existing law (R.S. 15:168) requires the collection of court costs in courts of original criminal jurisdiction in the amount of \$45 until Aug. 1, 2016, and \$35 thereafter and provides that such funds shall be used and administered by the district public defender.

<u>Prior law</u> required 30% of the funds collected by the city court of New Iberia pursuant to existing law to be deposited into the New Iberia Public Defender Fund.

<u>Prior law</u> required 30% of the funds collected by the Jeanerette City Court pursuant to <u>existing law</u> to be deposited into the Jeanerette Public Defender Fund.

<u>Prior law</u> required 30% of the funds collected by the city court of Breaux Bridge pursuant to existing law to be deposited into the Breaux Bridge Public Defender Fund.

<u>New law</u> changes <u>prior law</u> by authorizing instead of requiring 30% of those funds collected by the city courts of Morgan City, New Iberia, Jeanerette, and Breaux Bridge to be deposited in each city's public defender fund.

Effective August 1, 2017.
