Existing law provides a listing of certain fees that the marshal of the city of Hammond shall be entitled to in civil matters and further authorizes the marshal to collect a minimum fee of \$10 for services in certain civil matters.

Existing law (R.S. 13:1883) provides the marshal of the city of Hammond with a minimum salary of \$6,000 payable monthly in equal proportions by the governing authority and the parish.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that the marshal is entitled to use up to \$15,500 annually of the fees of office to defray operational expenses as may be useful and necessary for the proper conduct of the office of the marshal.

<u>New law</u> removes this provision of <u>prior law</u> and authorizes the marshal to use up to \$39,586 annually of the fees collected to supplement his salary and benefits, and requires that the total compensation and benefits paid to the marshal of the city of Hammond shall not exceed \$111,585 annually. <u>New law</u> further requires the remainder of the fees and commissions collected to be used to defray operational expenses as may be useful and necessary for the proper conduct of the office of the marshal.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 22, 2017).
