<u>Prior law</u> authorized court reporters in the 14th JDC in Calcasieu Parish to charge \$2.25 per page for originals and \$.25 per page for copies for all cases which are reported and transcribed for appeal, and for all cases which are reported but not transcribed, one-half of those fees.

<u>New law</u> increases the fees <u>from</u> \$2.25 <u>to</u> \$3.25 per page for originals and <u>from</u> \$.25 <u>to</u> \$.75 for copies that court reporters in the 14th JDC in Calcasieu Parish can charge for all cases which are reported and transcribed for appeal.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the court administrator for the 14th JDC to establish a criminal indigent transcript fund for deposit of all monies received for payment of court reporter fees for transcripts prepared for indigents.

<u>Existing law</u> requires the fund to be used only to compensate criminal court reporters for preparation of any transcript for indigent defendants, including trials, motions, hearings on writs, and all court proceedings.

<u>Prior law</u> required that the court reporters be paid a fee of \$2.25 per 31-line page and \$.25 per page copy in all cases, by the court administrator, as funds become available.

New law increases the court reporter fees $\underline{\text{from}}$ \$2.25 $\underline{\text{to}}$ \$3.25 per 32-line page and $\underline{\text{from}}$ \$.25 $\underline{\text{to}}$ \$.75 per page copy on transcripts for indigent defendants.

<u>New law</u> repeals a duplicative provision of law referring to court reporter fees in Calcasieu Parish.

<u>New law</u> becomes effective upon a recommendation by the Judicial Council in its 2018 report.
