Falconer

Existing law provides that a public building owned by the state, a political subdivision of the state, or by any institution receiving support from the state shall not be named in honor of any living person, unless otherwise authorized or provided by law.

New law authorizes the governing authority of St. Tammany Parish to name the Madisonville branch library in honor of Peter L. "Pete" Gitz.

Effective August 1, 2017.
