Existing House Rule provides for the subject matter jurisdiction of each standing committee.

Prior House Rule provided that laws regulating clean water, drinking water, and ground water were within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Committee on Natural Resources and Environment.

New House Rule provides instead that laws regulating water resources are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Committee on Natural Resources and Environment and that drinking water standards are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Committee on Health and Welfare.

Effective February 22, 2017.
