Stokes

Prior law defined aviation gasoline as set forth in Number D910 of the American Society for Testing and Materials.

New law redefines "aviation gasoline" as any gasoline which is intended for or primarily used for propelling aircraft and which is invoiced, received, sold, stored, or withdrawn from storage by any person for propelling aircraft.

New law specifies that motor fuel intended to propel motor vehicles is not "aviation gasoline".

Effective July 1, 2017.
