<u>Existing law</u> prevents the state from having any liability for damage caused by a district attorney, coroner, assessor, sheriff, clerk of court, or other public officer of a political subdivision.

<u>New law</u> creates an exception to <u>existing law</u> and requires the state to indemnify the district attorney's office against claims or suits in federal court based on the constitutional validity of a statute when the district attorney's office has not initiated any prosecution based upon that statute.

<u>New law</u> provides that payment of a final judgment or payment of legal services shall be made by legislative appropriation and any payment must be approved by a subcommittee of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget (JLCB).

<u>New law</u> provides that the attorney defending the claim must present a detailed abstract of the facts of the case and the calculation of fees to the subcommittee of the JLCB.

<u>New law</u> requires the abstract submitted by the defense attorney and the amount of the final judgment to be a public record, except material that reflects the mental impressions, conclusions, opinions, or theories of an attorney.
