Peacock

<u>Present law</u> provides for the survivor benefit for the spouse and children of a member of Louisiana State Employees' Retirement System (LASERS) hazardous duty service plan (R.S. 11:611) who was killed in the line of duty or died from the direct result of an injury received while in the line of duty. <u>Present law</u> provides that the benefit shall be equal to 80% of the member's average compensation without regard to the amount of time that the deceased was a member of the plan.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the survivor benefit for the spouse and children of a member of the hazardous duty service plan (R.S. 11:611) killed in the line of duty by an intentional act of violence. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the benefit shall be equal to 100% of the member's average compensation without regard to the amount of time that the deceased was a member of the plan.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the LASERS board of trustees shall electronically notify all members of the legislature when a survivor benefit is granted pursuant to <u>proposed law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Sheriffs' Pension and Relief Fund board of trustees shall electronically notify all members of the legislature when a survivor benefit is granted pursuant to present law (R.S. 11:2178(D)(4)).

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
