To amend and reenact R.S. 11:2094, relative to the Registrars of Voters Employees'

Officers and employees of board 11 The board of trustees shall elect from its membership a chairman and shall 12 by a majority vote of all its members appoint a director, who may be, but need not 13 be, one of its members and may be a natural person or juridical person. The board 14 of trustees shall engage such actuarial and other services as shall be required to 15 transact the business of the retirement system. The compensation of all persons 16 engaged by the board of trustees, and all other expenses of the board necessary for 17 the operation of the retirement system shall be paid at such rates and in such amounts 18 as the board of trustees shall approve. 19 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 20 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

Abstract: Allows a natural person or juridical person to serve as director of the Registrars of Voters Employees' Retirement System (ROVERS).

<u>Present law</u> requires that the board of trustees of ROVERS appoint a director by a majority vote of all board members. Further provides that the director may be a board member. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the director may be a natural person or a juridical person.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
