HOUSING. Provides relative to the civil service status of employees of the Housing Authority of the City of Lafayette. (8/1/18)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 40:539(C)(8)(f), relative to employees of the Housing Authority of the City
3 of Lafayette; to provide that employees of the authority shall not be in the state civil
4 service; and to provide for related matters.

5 Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 40:539(C)(8)(f) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §539. Selection of chairman and vice chairman; executive director; hiring of

12 (8) * * *

13 **(f) Notwithstanding any provision of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph**
14 **or of any other law to the contrary, the Housing Authority of the City of**
15 **Lafayette shall not be considered to be an instrumentality of the state for**
16 **purposes of Article X, Section 1(A) of the Constitution of Louisiana, and**
17 **employees of the authority shall not be included in the state civil service.**

Proposed law authorizes the Housing Authority of the City of Lafayette to not be considered to be an instrumentality of the state for purposes of Article X, Section 1(A) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

Proposed law provides for employees of the Housing Authority of the City of Lafayette to not be included in the state civil service.

Effective August 1, 2018.
