1 A. The secretary shall institute a pilot program in which each able-bodied,
 2 non-pregnant adult, who is not exempted by the provisions of R.S. 46:460.104, will
 3 be ineligible for Medicaid benefits unless he meets one or more of the following
 4 criteria:"

6 On page 4, between lines 10 and 11, insert the following:

7 "B.(1) The pilot initiative shall operate exclusively in two parishes of this
 8 state selected by the secretary.

9 (2) The secretary shall select for the pilot initiative two parishes in different
 10 geographic regions of the state. The parishes selected shall have significantly
 11 different population characteristics with respect to demographics and income, and
 12 have significantly different types of business and economic activity and educational
 13 resources."

14 AMENDMENT NO. 14

15 On page 4, at the beginning of line 11, change "§460.105." to "§460.104."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 15

17 On page 4, line 12, delete "R.S. 46:460.104" and insert in lieu thereof "R.S. 46:460.103"

19 On page 4, between lines 25 and 26, insert the following:

20 "§460.105. Program evaluation; reporting to legislative committees

21 A. On a semiannual basis, the department shall submit a report to the House
 22 Committee on Appropriations, the Senate Committee on Finance, and the House and
 23 Senate committees on health and welfare concerning the pilot initiative created by
 24 the provisions of this Part which encompasses, at minimum, all of the following
 25 information:

26 (1) The total number of participants in the pilot initiative.

27 (2) The total number of Medicaid enrollees exempted from participation in
 28 the pilot initiative.

29 (3)(a) Data on disenrollment from Medicaid of pilot initiative enrollees who
 30 fail to meet the initiative's work and community engagement requirements.

31 (b) Data, if available, on healthcare access by alternative sources of health
 32 services financing for former Medicaid beneficiaries who are disenrolled from
 33 Medicaid for failing to meet the initiative's work and community engagement
 34 requirements.

35 (4)(a) Health status of pilot initiative participants.

36 (b) Health outcomes, including mental health and behavioral health
 37 outcomes, within the population participating in the pilot initiative.

38 (c) Comparison of health status and outcomes of pilot initiative participants
 39 versus non-participants within the pilot initiative parishes, and versus able-bodied,
 40 non-pregnant adult Medicaid enrollees statewide.

41 (5) Changes in health system utilization by pilot initiative participants.

42 (6) Workforce participation rates over time among pilot initiative
 43 participants.

44 (7) Income gains over time among pilot initiative participants.

45 (8) Gains in educational attainment among pilot initiative participants.

46 (9) Administrative costs and overall costs of the pilot initiative.

47 (10) An evaluation of the effectiveness of the pilot initiative.

1 (11) Any other information concerning the pilot initiative that the secretary
2 deems necessary or appropriate.

3 B. The House Committee on Appropriations, the Senate Committee on
4 Finance, the House Committee on Health and Welfare, and the Senate Committee
5 on Health and Welfare may meet individually or jointly to conduct hearings
6 concerning the data and other information presented in the report required by
7 Subsection A of this Section, and to evaluate the effectiveness of the pilot initiative
8 created by the provisions of this Part."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 17

10 On page 4, line 28, after "the" and before "program" insert "pilot"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 18

12 On page 5, between lines 3 and 4, insert the following:

13 "§460.107. Termination

14 The provisions of this Part shall terminate on January 1, 2021."
