Abstract: Provides for the effects of a misstatement or suppression of fact in an application for an alcoholic beverage permit or an accompanying affidavit.

Present law, regarding permits for dealers in beverages of low alcoholic content, provides that any misstatement or suppression of fact in an application or accompanying affidavit is a ground for the denial, withholding, or suspension of a permit.

Proposed law retains present law and makes it applicable to permits for dealers in high alcoholic content beverages. Further adds that a misstatement or suppression of fact may also result in the filing of criminal charges.
