Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that beginning October 1, 2018, the membership of each charter school governing or management board shall include at least one member who is a parent or legal guardian of a student enrolled in the charter school who is elected by the parents or legal guardians representing at least a majority of the students at the charter school.

Proposed law deletes obsolete time line in present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
