AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 14:82(C)(3), relative to prostitution; to provide relative to penalties; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 14:82(C)(3) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§82. Prostitution; definition; penalties; enhancement

(3) On a third and subsequent conviction, the offender shall be imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not less than two years nor more than four years and shall be fined not less than five hundred dollars nor more than four thousand dollars.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
