- 5 "§52.1. Change in expenditure limit
- A change to the expenditure limit shall be made pursuant to a concurrent resolution adopted by a favorable vote of two-thirds of the elected members of each house directing the commissioner of administration to change the expenditure limit to a designated amount for a specified fiscal year. If the legislature is not in session, the two-thirds consent requirement shall be obtained as provided in R.S. 39:87."
