R.S. 22:1931.13 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 11 §1931.13. Termination of Part This Part shall terminate on August 1, 2018 July 1, 2020. 12 13 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2018; if vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1, 14 2018, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later. 15

SB 153 Original

<u>Present law</u> provides that provisions concerning the authority and funding of the insurance fraud investigation unit in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections will be null, void, and unenforceable on July 1, 2018.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the Sledge Jeansonne Louisiana Insurance Fraud Prevention Act, which allows the attorney general to institute civil proceedings against any person who commits certain fraudulent insurance acts, terminates August 1, 2018.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends these provisions of <u>present law</u> until July 1, 2020.

Effective July 1, 2018.
