



- (b) A heat advisory has been issued by a local or state authority or jurisdiction for the area in which the dog or cat is tied, tethered, or restrained.
- (c) A hurricane, tropical storm, severe weather, or tornado warning has been issued by the National Weather Service for the area in which the dog or cat is tied, tethered, or restrained.

Proposed law provides for a penalty of not less than \$100 nor more than \$300 per violation.

Proposed law makes technical corrections to present law.

Effective August 1, 2018.
