CURRICULA: Requires instruction in public high schools on prevention of shaken baby syndrome

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 17:270 and 3996(B)(45), relative to required instruction; to require public high
schools to provide instruction in the recognition and prevention of shaken baby
syndrome; and to provide for related matters.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 17:270 and 3996(B)(45) are hereby enacted to read as follows:
§270. Shaken baby syndrome; instruction
A. Each public high school shall provide instruction in the recognition and
prevention of shaken baby syndrome. Such instruction shall be integrated into an
existing course of study.
B. For purposes of this Section, "shaken baby syndrome" means the
condition known also as abusive head trauma that is characterized by injuries
resulting from violent shaking or shaking and impacting of the head of an infant or
small child.

§3996. Charter schools; exemptions; requirements
* * *
B. Notwithstanding any state law, rule, or regulation to the contrary and
except as may be otherwise specifically provided for in an approved charter, a
charter school established and operated in accordance with the provisions of this

Chapter and its approved charter and the school's officers and employees shall be
exempt from all statutory mandates or other statutory requirements that are
applicable to public schools and to public school officers and employees except for
