PUBLIC RECORDS. Exempts certain Department of Agriculture and Forestry records from the Public Records Law. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact the introductory paragraph of R.S. 44:3(A), relative to public records;
3 to exempt certain records of the Department of Agriculture and Forestry from the
4 Public Records Law; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. The introductory paragraph of R.S. 44:3(A) is hereby amended and
7 reenacted to read as follows:

8 §3. Records of prosecutive, investigative, and law enforcement agencies and
9 communications districts

10 A. Nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to require disclosures of
11 records, or the information contained therein, held by the offices of the attorney
12 general, district attorneys, sheriffs, police departments, Department of Public Safety
13 and Corrections, marshals, investigators, public health investigators, correctional
14 agencies, communications districts, intelligence agencies, Council on Peace Officer
15 Standards and Training, Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and
16 Administration of Criminal Justice, **Department of Agriculture and Forestry**, or
17 publicly owned water districts of the state, which records are:
