Abstract: Provides a monetary exemption for highway designations honoring military personnel, law enforcement officers, and firefighters killed in the line of duty.

Proposed law prohibits the Dept. of Transportation and Development from requiring monies be received to alleviate costs, including payments to contractors, associated with the installation and maintenance of signage reflecting highway designations honoring military personnel, law enforcement officers, or firefighters killed in the line of duty.

Proposed law authorizes each legislator to propose up to five highway designations specified in proposed law, during each regular legislative session, before local or private monies are required to alleviate costs incurred by the Dept. of Transportation and Development.
