**Purpose of the Bill:** This bill provides that constables for justices of the peace are entitled to a 6% fee for collecting money for execution of a writ of fieri facias, without either seizure or sale. In addition, this bill provides that garnishment judgments will be paid to the sheriff, marshal, or constable for processing prior to being paid to the seizing creditor.


There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.
