1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1742(A), relative to unemployment insurance; to provide for

3 notice of assessment; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 23:1742(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

6 §1742. Notice of assessment; reassessment

7 A. The administrator shall notify the claimant of the assessment by sending

8 a notice of assessment **electronically**, by **first-class**, certified, or registered mail to

9 the claimant's or his authorized representative's last known address.
