HOUSE BILL NO. 426

BY REPRESENTATIVE HUVAL

PROPERTY/PUBLIC: Authorizes the transfer of state property in St. Martin Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to authorize the transfer  
3 of certain state property in St. Martin Parish; to provide for the property description;  
4 to provide for reservation of mineral rights; to provide terms and conditions; to  
5 provide an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The commissioner of the division of administration, notwithstanding any  
8 other provision of law to the contrary, is hereby authorized and empowered to convey,  
9 transfer, assign, lease, or deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have  
10 to all or any portion of a parcel of state property in St. Martin Parish to Ciriaque Degeyter.

11 Section 2. The commissioner of the division of administration is hereby authorized  
12 to enter into such agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such  
13 documents as necessary to properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease  
14 or delivery of title, excluding mineral rights, to the property described in Section 1 of this  
15 Act, and as more specifically described in any such agreements entered into and documents  
16 executed by and between the commissioner of the division of administration and Ciriaque  
17 Degeyter in exchange of consideration proportionate to the appraised value of the property.

18 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
19 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
20 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

- 1 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
2 effective on the day following such approval.
