Abstract: Creates the crime of failure to identify the possession of a concealed handgun to a law enforcement officer.

Proposed law requires a person who is authorized to possess a concealed handgun under present law to notify as soon as is practical any uniformed law enforcement officer who approaches that person in the official performance of his duties that he has a weapon on his person, submit to a pat down, and allow the officer to temporarily disarm him.

Proposed law provides penalties for failure to notify a law enforcement officer of the possession of a concealed handgun of a fine not to exceed \$1,000. Further authorizes the forfeiture of the handgun and the suspension or revocation of a permit or license to carry the handgun.
