ENVIRONMENT/AIR: Prohibits the open burning of munitions and waste explosives

2	To enact R.S. 30:2054(B)(2)(c), relative to air quality; to provide for the authority of the
3	secretary of the Department of Environmental Quality; to prohibit the open burning
4	of munitions and waste explosives; to provide for an effective date; and to provide
5	for related matters.

9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
10	Section 1. R.S. 30:2054(B)(2)(c) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
11	§2054. Air quality control; secretary of environmental quality; powers and duties

13	B. The secretary shall have the following powers and duties:

17	(c) The secretary shall not issue, pursuant to the authority granted by this
18	Chapter or by R.S. 30:2171 et seq., any permit, license, variance, or compliance
19	schedule that authorizes, nor shall the secretary allow in any manner, the open
20	burning of any munitions or waste explosives within ten miles of the town of Colfax.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words underscored are additions.

The prohibition provided for in this Subparagraph shall not apply to agricultural
burning and shall not apply to flaring not related to munitions and waste explosive
burning.

Abstract: Prohibits the open burning of munitions and waste explosives within 10 miles of Colfax.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Environmental Quality to develop permitting procedures and regulations for all sources of air contaminants and to develop a comprehensive state hazardous waste control program.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits any person from discharging air contaminants without the appropriate permit or license issued by the secretary.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits the secretary from issuing any permit, license, variance, or compliance schedule authorizing, nor shall the secretary allow in any manner, the open burning of any munitions or waste explosives within 10 miles of the town of Colfax.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for an exception from the prohibition in <u>proposed law</u> for agricultural burning and flaring not related to munitions and waste explosive burning.
