Abstract: Provides relative to the confidentiality of records of reports of child abuse and neglect.

<u>Present law</u> requires records of child abuse or neglect to be confidential, but permits the Dept. of Children and Family Services to promulgate rules regarding the release of such information.

<u>Proposed law</u> incorporates changes to <u>present law</u> proposed by Act No. 348 of the 2017 R.S. regarding the confidentiality of the identity of an alleged perpetrator of child abuse or neglect. <u>Proposed law</u> adds that the Dept. of Children and Family Services is required to provide otherwise confidential information to the court or district attorney's office when necessary for the court to protect a child from abuse or neglect.
