Abstract: Requires notice of any changes in the registration information and provides for the termination of an apprenticeship.

Present law establishes the Bail Bond Apprentice Program within the Dept. of Insurance.

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law requires a registrant and supervising bail bond producer to notify the commissioner of insurance of any changes to the registration information within three days of the effective date of the change.

Proposed law requires the supervising bail bond producer to notify the commissioner of the termination of an incomplete apprenticeship within three days of the termination.

Proposed law provides that an apprenticeship shall terminate if not completed within six months of the date of initial registration.
