## DIGEST 2018 Regular Session

Mizell

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 3:4105) prohibits the Dairy Stabilization Board from regulating or establishing retail prices of milk and milk products, provided that any such sales shall be subject to the condition of open market competition in compliance with the disruptive trade practice provisions of <u>present</u> law.

Proposed law retains present law.

SB 434 Original

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that any advertisement, offer to sell, or sale of any milk and milk products by a retailer at less than cost is not an unfair method of competition, unfair or deceptive act or practice, or disruptive trade practice.

<u>Proposed law</u> further prohibits the board or commissioner from requiring a price markup on the sale of any milk and milk products by a retailer.

Effective August 1, 2018.
