To enact R.S. $47: 1952(\mathrm{H})$, relative to the assessment of ad valorem taxes for certain commercial watercraft; to provide for place and time of listing and assessment; to provide for terms and conditions; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
Section 1. R.S. 47:1952(H) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
§1952. Place and time of listing and assessment
H. All commercial watercraft, as defined in R.S. 47:818.2, shall be deemed situated in the parish or district of its home port, as fixed by the owner on the commercial watercraft's registration.
