CHILDREN OR NO IMPACT See Note Provides relative to parental drug testing before allowing a foster child to return to the home.

Relative to children returning home from foster care, <u>present law</u> provides that lack of parental compliance with a case plan may be evidenced by one of more of the following: parent's failure to attend scheduled visitations, communicate with the child, provide their whereabouts, contribute to the costs of the foster care, comply with the required rehabilitation services, substantially improve recurring problems, and improve conditions that led to removal. <u>Proposed law</u> adds failure to provide a negative test result for synthetic controlled dangerous substances to the list.
