Present law provides relative to notary examinations. Provides that written examination administered by the Secretary of State shall be on the first Saturday of June and December. Proposed law provides that the Secretary of State can administer the notary examination more than twice a year, and that all examination dates will be determined by the Secretary of State.

## REVENUE EXPLANATION

The Secretary of State may collect additional fee revenue to the extent more than 2 exams are given per year, and more individuals register for the notary exam. Over the past 3 years, there has been an average of 1,661 applicants per year. However, the potential number of increased applicants is indeterminable.
