## DIGEST 2018 Regular Session

John Smith

Proposed law makes technical changes to conform to existing language in present law.

<u>Present law</u> provides that no adjuster's license is required for a person employed or retained by an insurer and brought into this state for the purpose of investigating or making adjustment of losses resulting from a catastrophe or emergency. Requires the commissioner of insurance to establish procedures to register all such unlicensed adjusters.

<u>Present law</u> provides that a catastrophe or emergency claims adjuster license shall be effective for a period not to exceed 180 days.

<u>Proposed law</u> deletes reference to a "license" and provides that a catastrophe or emergency claims adjuster registration shall be effective for a period not to exceed 180 days.

Effective August 1, 2018.
