<u>Present law</u> provides relative to notary examinations. Provides that written examination administered by the Secretary of State shall be on the first Saturday of June and December. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Secretary of State can administer the notary examination more than twice a year, and that all examination dates will be determined by the Secretary of State.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The Secretary of State may collect additional fee revenue to the extent more than 2 exams are given per year, and more individuals register for the notary exam. Over the past 3 years, there has been an average of 1,661 applicants per year. However, the potential number of increased applicants is indeterminable.
