1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, delete line 2 in its entirety and insert "To amend and reenact R.S. 17:1801 and
3 to enact R.S. 14:40.8, relative to acts of hazing; to"4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 14 in their entirety

6 AMENDMENT NO. 37 On page 1, at the beginning of line 15, change "B.(1)(a)" to "(2)(a)"8 AMENDMENT NO. 49 On page 1, line 18, after "victim," insert the following:10 "or results in the victim having a blood alcohol concentration of at least .25
11 percent by weight based on grams of alcohol per one hundred cubic
12 centimeters of blood,"13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 in their entirety and insert the following:

15 "B. If any person serving as a representative or officer of an
16 organization, including any representative, director, trustee, or officer of any
17 national or parent organization of which any of the underlying entities
18 provided for in Paragraph (C)(3) of this Section is a sanctioned or recognized
19 member at the time of the hazing, knew and failed to report to law
20 enforcement that one or more of the organization's members were engaging
21 in or participating in the hazing of another person, the organization may be
22 subject to the following:"23 AMENDMENT NO. 624 On page 2, delete line 3 in its entirety and insert "(1) Payment of a fine of up to ten thousand
25 dollars."26 AMENDMENT NO. 727 On page 2, at the beginning of line 4, change "(b)" to "(2)"28 AMENDMENT NO. 829 On page 2, at the beginning of line 5, change "(c)" to "(3)"30 AMENDMENT NO. 931 On page 2, line 6, after "institution" delete the remainder of the line and insert the following:

1 "for a specific period of time as determined by the court. If the hazing results
2 in the serious bodily injury or death of the victim, or results in the victim
3 having a blood alcohol concentration of at least .25 percent by weight based
4 on grams of alcohol per one hundred cubic centimeters of blood, the period
5 of time shall be for not less than four years."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 10

7 On page 3, line 5, after "normal" delete the remainder of the line, insert a comma "," and
8 insert the following:

9 "customary, and necessary for a person's training and participation in an
10 athletic, physical"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 11

12 On page 3, line 11, after "institution." delete the remainder of the line, delete line 12 in its
13 entirety, and insert the following:

14 ""Organization" includes the national or parent organization of which
15 any of the underlying entities provided for in this Paragraph is a sanctioned
16 or recognized member at the time of the hazing."

24 On page 4, after line 9, add the following:

25 "Section 3. This Act shall be referred to as "The Max Gruver Act".
