HOUSE BILL NO. 2

BY REPRESENTATIVE ABRAMSON

CAPITAL OUTLAY: Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget

1 AN ACT

2 To provide with respect to the capital outlay budget and the capital outlay program for state
3 government, state institutions, and other public entities; to provide for the designation
4 of projects and improvements; to provide for the financing thereof making
5 appropriations from certain sources; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The following sums or so much thereof as may be necessary are hereby
8 appropriated out of any monies in the state treasury from the sources specified, from federal
9 funds and self-generated revenues belonging to the state of Louisiana and/or collected by
10 boards, commissions, departments, and agencies thereof, all for making capital outlay and
11 for the purposes and in the amounts specified herein for the Fiscal Year commencing July
12 1, 2018, and ending June 30, 2019, subject to the conditions thereafter provided:

13 A project with funding payable from General Obligation Bonds Priority 1 indicates that
14 the funding for the project includes the reauthorization of funding which was previously
15 granted as a line of credit by the State Bond Commission in Fiscal Year 2017-2018. As used
16 in this Section, the term "general obligation bonds" means state general obligation bonds or
17 other evidences of indebtedness payable from the Bond Security and Redemption Fund. The
18 amount set forth in this Section opposite each project, or so much thereof as may be
19 necessary, is hereby appropriated and payable from the source of funding indicated;
20 provided, however, amounts appropriated and payable from federal funds may be
21 encumbered or expended only to the extent such amounts shall have been committed or

1 received. Pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 39:82, funds for planning, acquisition,
2 construction, and major repair projects appropriated by this Act may be retained until
3 completion of the project, even if no bona fide liability exists on the last day of the fiscal
4 year.

5 This Act shall constitute the comprehensive state capital outlay budget for the 2018-2019
6 Fiscal Year. Projects set forth which are payable from the proceeds available from the sale
7 of general obligation bonds shall have the priorities as indicated. The Request for Line of
8 Credit form used by the attorney general and Bond Counsel in evaluating Louisiana
9 Constitutional, Internal Revenue Code, and applicable income tax regulations shall be filed
10 with the commissioner of administration, State Bond Commission, and state attorney
11 general. No general obligation bonds shall be sold, nor cash lines of credit granted to fund
12 any lower priority project prior to the sale of general obligation bonds or the granting of cash
13 lines of credit to fund all higher priority projects (the "general rule"), except as hereinafter
14 provided. This prohibition against funding a lower priority project shall not apply upon a
15 showing of an impossibility or impracticality either to proceed with all unfunded higher
16 priority projects or to proceed with the funding of such projects or any part thereof through
17 the issuance of general obligation bonds for any reason. Such showing shall be stated in
18 reasonable detail in a certificate or certificates signed by the state agency responsible for
19 administering the funding, and filed with the commissioner of administration and the State
20 Bond Commission (hereinafter referred to as "the Commission"). Upon a determination by
21 the Commission that proceeding with such a project or the funding thereof through the
22 issuance of general obligation bonds is impractical or impossible, the Commission may then
23 proceed with the sale of general obligation bonds or the granting of cash lines of credit
24 without regard to the priority of the unfunded projects determined to be impossible or
25 impractical.

26 Upon recommendation by the state agency responsible for administering the funding, if
27 it is determined at any time that proceeding with the project or with the funding thereof is
28 no longer impossible or impractical, the State Bond Commission may rescind the certificate
29 of impossibility or impracticality and may proceed with the project or with the issuance of
30 general obligation bonds or the granting of cash lines of credit to fund the project.

1 Alternatively, the Interim Emergency Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board"), upon
2 reviewing certificates as described above and determining that proceeding with such project
3 or the funding thereof through the issuance of general obligation bonds is impossible or
4 impractical, may designate a lower priority for such project. The Board's determination and
5 lower priority designation shall be submitted to the members of the legislature for their
6 approval in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3-B of Subtitle I of Title 39 of the
7 Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950. In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3-B of
8 Subtitle I of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, whenever at the written
9 request of the appropriate legislators and agency, the Board determines that an adjustment
10 to a project description originally set forth in such capital budget adopted by the legislature
11 for a current fiscal year is necessary to correct a mistake in a project description, clarify a
12 description, change the scope of a description, or make any other adjustment the Board
13 deems necessary to implement the purpose of the project, such adjustment shall become
14 effective only upon the approval by majority vote of the elected members of each house of
15 the legislature in the manner provided for in Chapter 3-B of Subtitle I of Title 39 of the
16 Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

17 If such approval is granted, notification by the chair or secretary of the Board of the
18 results of the balloting shall be transmitted to the State Bond Commission, which may then
19 proceed with the sale of general obligation bonds or the granting of cash lines of credit for
20 each change approved upon request of the commissioner of administration in accordance
21 with the general rule.

22 With respect to Priorities 1 through 5, a lower priority project may be moved to a higher
23 priority only upon a showing of an emergency or other cause not reasonably anticipated by
24 the legislature, which shall be stated in reasonable detail in a certificate signed by the head
25 of the appropriate department, political subdivision, or agency and filed with the
26 commissioner of administration and the Board. Upon a determination by the Board that such
27 project should be moved to a higher priority because of an emergency or other cause not
28 reasonably anticipated by the legislature, the Board shall designate a higher priority to the
29 project. The matter then shall be submitted to and be subject to the same approval by the
30 members of the legislature in the manner previously indicated in this Section. If such

1 approval is granted, notification by the chair or secretary of the board of the change of
2 priority shall be transmitted to the State Bond Commission, which then upon request of the
3 commissioner of administration, may proceed with the sale of general obligation bonds or
4 the granting of cash lines of credit in accordance with the general rule. As to projects within
5 a priority, the State Bond Commission acting on requests submitted by the commissioner of
6 administration shall determine when such project, or phases thereof, shall be funded. In
7 making such determination, the State Bond Commission shall consider the amount of
8 proceeds of general obligation bonds to be made available in light of money and capital
9 market conditions; the expenditure requirements of the project; the time required for
10 architectural plans and drawings, public bidding, and site acquisition and preparation;
11 availability of receipt of federal monies; litigation affecting the undertaking or completion
12 of a project; federal tax laws and regulations regarding the sale of municipal bonds; and
13 other items of a similar nature bearing upon the possibility or the necessity to commence a
14 project or any particular phase thereof.

15 Any other provision of this Act to the contrary notwithstanding, projects described in
16 Priority 5 of this Act shall not be moved to a higher priority except upon one of the
17 following conditions: (1) Funding is necessary to complete or additionally fund a project
18 located elsewhere in the Capital Outlay Act. Determination of such condition shall be made
19 by the head of the appropriate department or agency by means of a certificate to that effect
20 filed with the Interim Emergency Board, who shall, by mail ballot, request approval of such
21 change and if approved by a majority of each house of the legislature it shall be funded, or
22 (2) unless required by an emergency or other cause not reasonably anticipated by the
23 legislature, to be in accordance with procedures set forth in this Section. However, the State
24 Bond Commission may authorize a non-cash line of credit for any project in Priority 5 which
25 represents that portion of construction contracts which were let during a previous fiscal year,
26 or construction contracts which will be let during the current fiscal year, but which will not
27 require cash expenditures during the year. Such non-cash lines of credit, when combined
28 with previously sold bonds or with higher priority bonds or lines of credit, or with funds
29 appropriated from other sources, will provide sufficient appropriated funds to award

1 equipment or construction contracts. Contracts shall not be awarded without approval of the
2 division of administration.

3 Upon approval by the State Bond Commission, and subject to compliance with its
4 policies and procedures and the procedures set forth herein, a line of credit providing for the
5 use of funds in anticipation of the sale of general obligation bonds may be granted to the
6 appropriate administering agency or department from the Comprehensive Capital Outlay
7 Escrow Account, or if there is not a sufficient amount available in such account, from other
8 available state cash in the state treasury, for capital improvement projects for which bond
9 proceeds are appropriated by a current capital budget, prior to the actual issuance of bonds
10 for such projects, unless the attorney general advises that an impediment exists to the valid
11 issuance of the bonds on the date such line of credit is granted.

12 All bonds that are to be repaid, in whole or in part, by revenues generated by the project
13 shall be designated as "Reimbursement Bonds". The State Bond Commission shall enter
14 into such agreements as are necessary to provide that the agency or subdivision, whose
15 project is reimbursable, shall pay the bond debt costs into the Bond Security and Redemption
16 Fund. Such costs may be paid annually or at the end of the term of the bonds issued as
17 determined by the State Bond Commission.

18 Priority 1 general obligation bond funding shall be limited to:

19 (1) Projects and amounts which were previously authorized by Act 4 of the 2017 Second
20 Extraordinary Session of the Legislature; and which were granted cash lines of credit by the
21 State Bond Commission. The bonds to fund these projects were not sold in Fiscal Year
22 2017-2018.

23 (2) The reauthorization of the portion of the outstanding Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Priority
24 5 Non-Cash Lines of Credit for projects which will require cash expenditures in Fiscal Year
25 2018-2019 and therefore must be converted to Cash Lines of Credit in Fiscal Year 2018-
26 2019.

27 (3) Commitments made in the Higher Education Desegregation Settlement Agreement.

28 Priority 2 general obligation bond projects are for the completion of plans and
29 specifications, land acquisition, site preparation, or for construction which will begin during

1 the fiscal year. It is presently anticipated that the listed projects will require the sale of
2 bonds or extension of lines of credit during the fiscal year after adoption of this Act.

3 Priority 3 general obligation bond projects are for the preparation of plans and
4 specifications, land acquisition, site preparation, or for construction and shall be limited to
5 funding for the portion of construction contracts which will not require cash expenditures
6 during the fiscal year. The projects in this category shall be considered future year projects
7 in the state's five-year capital outlay plan. It is presently anticipated that the listed projects
8 will not require the sale of bonds or extension of lines of credit during the fiscal year.

9 Priority 4 general obligation bond projects are for the preparation of plans and
10 specifications, land acquisition, site preparation, or for construction and shall be limited to
11 funding for the portion of construction contracts which will not require cash expenditures
12 during the fiscal year. The projects in this category shall be considered future year projects
13 in the state's five-year capital outlay plan. It is presently anticipated that the listed projects
14 will not require the sale of bonds or extension of lines of credit during the fiscal year.

15 Priority 5 general obligation bond funding shall be limited to funding for the portion of
16 construction contracts which will not require cash expenditures during the fiscal year. These
17 funds, when combined with previously sold bonds or with higher priority bonds on lines of
18 credit, or with funds appropriated from other sources, will provide sufficient appropriated
19 funds to award contracts. Non-cash lines of credit shall be required prior to the award of
20 these contracts.

21 In accordance with the cash management plan adopted pursuant to R.S. 48:251(D) and
22 the provisions of Act 161 of the 1998 First Extraordinary Session, the Department of
23 Transportation and Development is authorized to enter into contracts or agreements for
24 projects approved pursuant to the Highway Priority Program, Airport Construction and
25 Development Priority Program, Port Construction and Development Priority Program, and
26 Statewide Flood Control Program for projects bid and awarded, authorized, or commenced
27 during the fiscal year which do not require cash expenditures for the full contract or
28 agreement amount.

13 Section 2. The expenditure of funds appropriated in this Act, except appropriations
 14 made to nonprofit economic development corporations, shall be in conformity to all existing
 15 statutes relative to public bidding, contractual review, and R.S. 39:101 through 128 and any
 16 other statutes affecting the capital outlay program for state government, state institutions,
 17 and political entities. No contract shall be awarded for any project prior to the granting of
 18 a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State Bond Commission, determination by the
 19 state treasurer that cash funding is available in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow
 20 Account for the project, or delivery of revenue bonds whose issuance is authorized in
 21 Section 1 of this Act.

22 Section 3. Payment for projects specified in this Act must be made by warrant
 23 submitted to the division of administration, Department of Transportation and Development,
 24 the state treasurer or other administering agency as provided in Section 8, whichever is
 25 appropriate, only to the extent of funds required for immediate payment. Copies of invoices
 26 or other supporting documentation shall be submitted with warrants. In the event that any
 27 equipment included in this Act, is procured pursuant to the provisions of the State Lease-
 28 Purchase Act, R.S. 39:1761 et seq., the amounts included in this Act for each such piece of
 29 equipment shall not be appropriated. The provisions of R.S. 39:1771 which require
 30 equipment to be leased under the State Lease-Purchase Act to be included in the executive
 31 budget and approved by the legislature through inclusion in the General Appropriation Act
 32 shall be considered waived upon the inclusion of such equipment in this Act. Projects
 33 contained in this Act may, at the direction of the division of administration and with the
 34 approval of the State Bond Commission, alternatively be funded through financing programs

1 heretofore or hereafter provided by a public trust and public corporation duly organized
2 pursuant to R.S. 9:2341 et seq., having for its beneficiary the state and the Louisiana Local
3 Government Environmental Facilities and Community Development Authority, pursuant to
4 R.S. 33:4548.1 et seq.

5 Section 4. If at any time during the Fiscal Year 2018-2019, the governor should find,
6 or the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget or the commissioner of administration
7 should report to the governor, that the receipts of the treasury are falling short or appear
8 likely to fall short of the revenue estimates for the fiscal year and that a cash deficit is likely
9 to be incurred, the governor shall take such steps as deemed necessary to prevent the
10 occurrence of a cash deficit. In the event that a capital outlay project funded in this Act falls
11 under an agency which is abolished or for which funds are not appropriated in the 2018-2019
12 General Appropriation Act, then the funds appropriated in this Act for such capital outlay
13 projects shall not be expended unless deemed necessary by the governor to protect life or
14 property. In the event that legislation is enacted which transfers facilities or programs for
15 which projects are funded in this Act, on behalf of one agency, institution, department, or
16 management board to another agency, institution, department, or management board, then
17 the projects in this Act shall be deemed transferred also.

18 Section 5. All monies appropriated by this Act and any applicable funds of a prior
19 capital outlay budget act adopted by the legislature shall be deposited by the state treasurer
20 in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account, established by this Section, in the
21 state treasury. In accordance with R.S. 36:764, no later than sixty days following the end
22 of each quarter, the state treasurer shall report to the Joint Legislative Committee on the
23 Budget and the commissioner of administration, all funds contained in the Miscellaneous
24 Fund of the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account. Notwithstanding any
25 provisions contained herein or other law to the contrary, any original issue premium or
26 accrued interest proceeds received pursuant to the sale of general obligation bonds shall
27 remain on deposit to the credit of the Bond Security and Redemption Fund until such time
28 as they may be utilized in accordance with U.S. Department of the Treasury Regulations
29 promulgated pursuant to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. All such monies shall be
30 administered according to the particular act pertaining to the fiscal year in which such

1 monies were appropriated. If it is determined by the director of the office of facility
2 planning and control, division of administration, that the funds appropriated by this Act or
3 any prior capital outlay budget act are not sufficient to complete the projects contained in
4 any capital outlay budget act, through unavoidable deficiencies in appropriation, including
5 administrative and legal requirements, the commissioner of administration, subject to
6 approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, may direct the use of interest
7 earned from the investment of general obligation bond or note proceeds in the
8 Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account, not to exceed an aggregate of five million
9 dollars in any one fiscal year, for the purpose of completing the projects contained in any
10 capital outlay budget act and such money shall be deemed appropriated in specific amounts
11 necessary for such purpose. All appropriations in this Act which are made as additions to
12 funds for previously authorized projects shall be included, for accounting purposes, in the
13 account of the previously authorized projects. If it is determined by the director of the office
14 of facility planning and control, division of administration, that it is cost effective and
15 practical to combine individual appropriations, the commissioner of administration, subject
16 to the approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, may direct that two or
17 more appropriations or parts thereof may be combined into a single project for accounting
18 and audit purposes. The commissioner of administration may direct that funding in the
19 various statewide and/or multiple parish projects for improvements for state facilities may
20 be transferred to any project, in this Act or any previous Capital Outlay Act, which require
21 supplemental funding for improvements for state facilities which qualify for funding through
22 the various statewide and/or multiple parish projects for improvements for state facilities.
23 The office of facility planning and control, division of administration is authorized to receive
24 settlements and vendor rebates not in excess of \$50,000 unless approved by the Joint
25 Legislative Committee on the Budget, and to add those receipts to the funding for projects
26 in this Act or any previous Capital Outlay Act for which project funds are received. The
27 office of facility planning and control, division of administration is authorized to receive
28 insurance payments and are hereby authorized to immediately repair facilities that suffer
29 insurance losses without those projects being included in the Act and shall report to the Joint
30 Legislative Committee on the Budget any expenditures from insurance funds received

1 pursuant to this section. A portion, as determined by the commissioner of administration and
2 not to exceed one percent (1%), of the funding for projects which qualify for the Percent for
3 Art Program and not to exceed \$450,000 for an individual, qualifying project, may be
4 transferred from the qualifying project budgets, to the Department of Culture, Recreation and
5 Tourism for costs of acquiring art and administering the program. For all Percent for Art
6 Program projects in this or any previous capital outlay, up to ten percent (10%) of the
7 aforementioned one percent (1%) may be used for the costs of administering the projects.

8 Section 6. Prior to March 1, 2019, each agency authorized to administer capital
9 outlay projects shall submit to the Joint Legislative Committee on Capital Outlay a list of
10 projects that are completed and the cash balances remaining in each project for any
11 completed project not included in the annual report submitted pursuant to R.S. 39:105 or in
12 the annual reports submitted pursuant to R.S. 39:112.

13 Section 7. The commissioner of administration, with the approval of the Joint
14 Legislative Committee on the Budget, is authorized to supplement or substitute the
15 appropriations specified in this or previous capital outlay acts with any federal or other funds
16 which are or may become available and such funds shall be deemed appropriated in specific
17 amounts necessary for the purposes of this Act. Any funds received by the State Bond
18 Commission as a result of a prepayment of reimbursement contracts as authorized by law
19 and the policy and procedure for reimbursement contracts of the Department of Treasury,
20 office of State Bond Commission, shall be deposited as set forth in such policy and
21 procedure and shall be deemed available and appropriated in specific amounts necessary for
22 the purposes of this Act pursuant to the procedure set forth in this section.

23 Section 8A. All of the funds herein appropriated, except for appropriations made to
24 the Department of Military Affairs, the Legislature, the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition
25 District, the Department of Economic Development, the Coastal Protection and Restoration
26 Authority, the Division of Administration for Supplemental State Funds for Local
27 Government Assistance Program, the Division of Administration for the Community Water
28 Enrichment Program or the Department of Transportation and Development, shall be
29 considered as having been appropriated directly to the Office of Facility Planning and

1 Control, Division of Administration, and all projects herein authorized and funded shall be
2 subject to the provisions of R.S. 39:101 through 128.

3 (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this act to the contrary or any other
4 provision of law, the appropriations made for the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District
5 shall be appropriated directly to the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District, and are
6 public purposes pursuant to the provisions of Article VII, Section 14 of the Constitution of
7 Louisiana primarily for economic development, including the generation of tax revenue,
8 creation of jobs, and the generation of tourism, and may be used to reimburse any
9 expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State
10 Bond Commission, determination by the State Treasurer that cash funding has been
11 deposited in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account for the project.

12 (2) The Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District may apply up to \$10,000,000 to
13 reimburse the New Orleans Pelicans NBA, LLC for costs incurred in constructing a new
14 training facility as contemplated by the Amended and Restated Arena Use Agreement dated
15 July, 1 2015; but, otherwise, contracts for projects funded through this appropriation shall
16 be awarded utilizing the public bid and contractual review process set forth in Chapter 10
17 of Title 38 and Chapter 17 of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, except with
18 respect to time requirements, or, in order to encourage competition for the projects funded
19 through this appropriation and to complete the projects in a timely manner, the Louisiana
20 Stadium and Exposition District shall have the authority to select a general contractor
21 through an RFP process whereby general contractors will bid general conditions and
22 contractor's fee based on the direct construction budget. The alternative time requirements
23 shall be approved by the Commissioner of Administration before the awarding of any such
24 contracts.

25 (3) Further, with respect to appropriations to the Louisiana Stadium and Exposition
26 District for the TPC Louisiana, Planning and Construction project, the Louisiana Stadium
27 and Exposition District shall be permitted to use alternative competitive procurement and
28 delivery methods for the award of any contracts to be funded through such appropriation.

29 (4) The Louisiana Stadium and Exposition District shall have the authority to
30 directly appoint a design professional from a list of a minimum of three architectural firms

1 or joint ventures with professional sports facility design experience acceptable to the
2 Commissioner of Administration and shall be exempt from other state requirements for
3 selection of designers. The design professional fee shall be in accordance with state
4 guidelines administered by the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of
5 Administration.

6 Section 8B.(1)(a) All of the funds appropriated in the Capital Outlay Act under the
7 name of non-state entities shall be administered by the Office of Facility Planning and
8 Control, Division of Administration, under cooperative endeavor agreements. Cooperative
9 endeavor agreements entered into pursuant to this Act, and approved by the Commissioner
10 of Administration or his designee, or the Secretary of the Department of Transportation and
11 Development for projects appropriated to or administered by the Department of
12 Transportation and Development, shall not be required to be submitted to the Division of
13 Administration, Office of Contractual Review.

14 (b) Further, for all projects in the Capital Outlay Act or a previous Capital Outlay
15 Act which are appropriated to the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of
16 Administration, including those administered by cooperative endeavor agreements, up to six
17 percent of each line-item may be used for costs of administering the projects.

18 (c) For all projects in Capital Outlay Act or a previous Capital Outlay Act
19 appropriated to the Department of Transportation and Development, up to six percent of
20 each line-item may be used for costs of administering the projects, or for field
21 engineering/construction supervision.

22 (2) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, or a previous Capital Outlay Act, the
23 Office of Facility Planning and Control may enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement
24 with the Archdiocese of New Orleans and Jefferson Parish for the Preservation and
25 Restoration of Historic Structure for Hope Haven/Madonna Manor Campus, Planning and
26 Construction project.

27 (3) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, or a previous Capital Outlay Act, the
28 Office of Facility Planning and Control may enter into a cooperative endeavor agreement
29 with Terrebonne Parish Recreation Districts Two and Three and Terrebonne Parish for the

1 Terrebonne Sports Complex Phase I, Infrastructure Improvements, Acquisition, Planning
2 and Construction project.

3 Section 8C. Line-item general obligation bond projects appropriated to the
4 Department of Transportation and Development in the Capital Outlay Act or a previous
5 Capital Outlay Act shall be authorized to draw Transportation Trust Funds from the
6 Highway Program appropriation, for supplemental funding on overruns in excess of the
7 original estimated project cost as determined by the Department of Transportation and
8 Development, provided however that said projects are in the state or federal highway system
9 and in the priority program, and the overrun is less than \$50,000. Any such overrun of
10 \$50,000 or more must be approved by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget.

11 Section 8D. All ports, levee districts and other non-state entities must have a fully
12 executed cooperative endeavor agreement, from the Office of Facility Planning and Control,
13 Department of Transportation and Development, or the State Treasurer, whichever is
14 appropriate, before entering into any contracts which obligate state funding and must follow
15 all laws pertaining to public bidding. If a port, levee district or other non-state entity enters
16 into a contract prior to receipt of funding, or prior to execution of a cooperative endeavor
17 agreement, then payments under such contracts are prohibited from capital outlay
18 appropriations, and are the sole responsibility of the port, levee district, or other non-state
19 entity.

20 Section 8E. Exemptions from timing provisions for funding and execution of
21 cooperative endeavor agreements and contracts

22 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any
23 previous capital outlay act, contracts may be entered into for the Atchafalaya Basin
24 Protection and Enhancement Kemper Williams project in St. Mary Parish prior to a
25 cooperative endeavor agreement being entered into with the state.

26 (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any
27 previous capital outlay act to the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may be
28 entered into for the Youngsville Sports Complex project in Lafayette Parish, prior to receipt
29 of funding and prior to execution of the cooperative endeavor agreement and the state is
30 authorized to financially participate in obligations created by such contracts.

1 (3) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary,
2 contracts may be entered into for the City of New Orleans, Eastern New Orleans Hospital
3 and Medical Office Building, Real Estate Acquisition, Planning, Design, Construction,
4 Renovation and Equipment project prior to receipt of funding and prior to execution of the
5 cooperative endeavor agreement.

6 (4) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, or the Capital Outlay Act, or any
7 other capital outlay act, contracts may be entered into for the Port of South Louisiana,
8 Globalplex Rail Siding; Globalplex Terminal Building #71 Upgrade, Planning and
9 Construction and/or Administration Building (also known as the Business Development
10 Center) projects prior to receipt of funding and prior to execution of a cooperative endeavor
11 agreement.

12 (5) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary
13 or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered into for the Greater Baton Rouge
14 Port Commission Inland Rivers Marine Terminal Dock and Access Roadway Construction
15 Project, Planning and Construction Project prior to receipt of funding and prior to the
16 execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement.

17 (6) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary
18 or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered into for the Outpatient Clinics in
19 Rapides Parish, Planning and Construction project for the Division of Administration prior
20 to the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement.

21 (7) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary
22 or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered into for the Mississippi River Levee
23 Raising, Arkansas to Old River project prior to receipt of funding, and the State is authorized
24 to financially participate in obligations created by such contracts.

25 (8) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the contrary
26 or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered into for the Old McKinley High
27 School Community Center on Thomas Delpit Drive in the City of Baton Rouge, Kitchen and
28 Building Renovations, Repairs and Upgrades Including Elevator Repair Project prior to
29 receipt of funding and prior to the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement, and
30 unless the Commissioner of Administration is advised by bond counsel to the state that such

1 may violate federal tax law, the appropriation may be used to reimburse any expenditure
2 made prior to the granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State Bond
3 Commission.

4 Section 8F. Pursuant to R.S. 39:112(E)(2), non-state entity projects shall require a
5 match of not less than twenty-five percent of the total requested amount of funding;
6 however,

7 (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 39:112(E)(2), the project for
8 Independence, Independence Area Community Pavilion, Planning and Construction, shall
9 be exempt from all local match requirements.

10 (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
11 contrary, any other provisions of law, or the provisions of R.S. 39:112(E)(2), the project for
12 Eden House, New Facility, Acquisition, Planning and Construction, shall be exempt from
13 all local match requirements.

14 (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, any
15 other provision of law, or the provisions of R.S. 39:112(E)(2) to the contrary, the project for
16 Lockport Street Improvements, Planning and Construction, shall be exempt from all local
17 match requirements.

18 (4) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, any prior Capital Outlay Act,
19 any other provision of law, or the provisions of R.S. 39:112(E)(2) to the contrary, the project
20 for the Village of Doyline Wastewater Treatment Facility shall be exempt from all local
21 match requirements.

22 Section 8G. Pursuant to R.S. 39:102, each capital outlay budget request submitted
23 as required by R.S. 39:101 shall include a detailed project description and justification for
24 each new project requested; however,

25 (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
26 contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in the Capital
27 Outlay Act or any other Capital Outlay Act for the St. Mary Parish Plantation Pump Station
28 Replacement project shall be deemed to include repair, equipment, rehabilitation and
29 infrastructure improvements at the existing Plantation Pump Station.

30 (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the

1 contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in this or any
2 other Capital Outlay Act for the Louisiana 4-H Foundation, Youth Education Development
3 Camp Windy Wood project, shall be deemed to include planning, construction, and
4 acquisition.

5 (3) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
6 contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in the Capital
7 Outlay Act or any other Capital Outlay Act for the Youngsville Parkway Road project shall
8 be deemed to include waterline improvements and roadway lighting.

9 (4) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
10 contrary, or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in the Capital
11 Outlay Act or any other Capital Outlay Act for the City of New Orleans, Eastern New
12 Orleans Hospital and Medical Office Building, Real Estate Acquisition, Planning, Design,
13 Construction, Renovation and Equipment project, the City of New Orleans may make such
14 capital outlay funds available to the Parish Hospital Service District of the Parish of Orleans
15 District "A" in furtherance of the District's planning, design, acquisition, development,
16 renovation, construction, equipment and operation of a hospital and medical office building
17 in Eastern New Orleans.

18 (5) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
19 contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in the Capital
20 Outlay Act or any other Capital Outlay Act for the Jefferson Parish Bonnabel Canal
21 Rehabilitation and Bank Stabilization (Veterans Boulevard to West Esplanade), Planning
22 and Construction project shall be deemed to include steel sheet pile bulkhead, and/or bank
23 excavation and reshaping, bridge replacement, property acquisition, demolition and
24 improvements needed to stabilize the canal bank along the Bonnabel Drainage Canal in
25 order to address canal bank failures between Veterans Boulevard and West Esplanade
26 Avenue.

27 (6) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
28 contrary or any other provision of law, the scope of the appropriations made in this or any
29 other Capital Outlay Act for the New Orleans West Bank Park Improvements, New Soccer
30 and Recreational Facilities, and Skateboard Park project and the Norman Playground

1 Basketball Gym, Planning and Construction project shall be deemed to include the George
2 W. Carver Playground, Renovations and Upgrades project for the West Bank Park project
3 and park enhancements for a walking track, basketball, football and baseball fields and a
4 concession stand for the Norman Playground project.

5 (7) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
6 contrary or any other provision of law, the Parks Municipal Complex, Planning and
7 Construction project shall include the purchase, construction or renovation of a new facility
8 in St. Martin Parish.

9 (8) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
10 contrary or any other provision of law, The Vernon/Fort Polk Thoroughfare Electrical Power
11 Extension project shall include Utilities Including Generators.

12 (9) Notwithstanding anything in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, any previous
13 capital outlay act, or other provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation
14 for the Port of South Louisiana Globalplex Terminal Building #71 Upgrade project shall be
15 deemed to also include similar upgrades for other Globalplex Terminal Buildings.

16 (10) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any
17 other provision of law to the contrary, the scope of the appropriation for the Department of
18 Transportation and Development, LA 22 Improvements (LA 16 to Diversion Canal),
19 Planning and Construction (Livingston) is deemed to also include the overlay of LA 22 from
20 Head of Island to Chinquapin Bridge.

21 (11) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act or a previous Capital Outlay
22 Act, any provision of law, or in any cooperative endeavor agreement between the Office of
23 Facility Planning and Control and Westwego, the scope of the appropriations in this or any
24 previous Capital Outlay Act for Westwego, The WHARF project shall be deemed to include
25 site preparation.

26 (12) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act or the Capital Outlay Act to the
27 contrary or any other provision of law, the Slip Dredging and Improvements for the
28 Terrebonne Port Commission Government Multi-Use Complex, Planning and Construction
29 project shall be deemed to include Houma Navigation Canal Dredging.

30 (13) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or a previous Capital Outlay

1 Act, any provision of law, or in any cooperative endeavor agreement between the Office of
2 Facility Planning and Control and the Pontchartrain Levee District, the scope of the
3 appropriations in this or any previous Capital Outlay Act for the Pontchartrain Levee
4 District, East St. Charles Urban Flood Control project shall be deemed to include planning,
5 design, and construction of the East St. Charles Urban Flood Control project, including the
6 Almedia, St. Rose, and Airport Pump Stations located in the eastern end of the East Bank
7 of St. Charles Parish.

8 (14) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act, or any
9 other Capital Outlay Act, the scope of the appropriation for the Department of
10 Transportation and Development, Jimmie Davis Bridge Rehabilitation and Lighting,
11 Planning and Construction project in Bossier and Caddo parishes, shall be deemed to include
12 the planning, design and construction of a new bridge.

13 Section 8H. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay
14 Act, or in any cooperative endeavor agreement between the Office of Facility Planning and
15 Control and the City of New Orleans or the Hospital Service District to the contrary, the
16 Hospital Service District may mortgage or otherwise encumber any and all land, real estate
17 property, including buildings and equipment, and appurtenances acquired, in whole or part,
18 with state capital outlay funds provided that bond counsel to the state opines that such
19 mortgage shall not affect the tax-exempt status of the bonds to be issued by the state for the
20 project.

21 Section 8I. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act
22 to the contrary or any other provision of law, the Parish Road Improvements Project for
23 Franklin Parish is exempt from the contract limit set forth in R.S. 38:2212.

24 Section 8J. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act
25 to the contrary or any other Act or provision of law, the appropriations made for the
26 Executive Department for facilities which promote economic development included in the
27 Repair, Restoration, and Replacement for Hurricanes Katrina and Rita project, and the
28 Department of Economic Development projects are for public purposes pursuant to the
29 provisions of Article VII, Section 14 of the Constitution of Louisiana primarily for economic
30 development, including the generation of tax revenues, creation of jobs, promotion of

1 tourism, and creation of facilities for charitable, cultural, artistic, educational, social, civic,
2 research, service, economic development activities, or provide facilities for professional golf
3 events, pursuant to the terms of cooperative endeavor agreements, including leases and all
4 expenditures of these appropriations and may be exempted, by the Commissioner of
5 Administration, from all statutes relative to public bidding, contractual review and the
6 provisions of R.S. 33:9029.2(D) and in lieu thereof be allowed to use alternative competitive
7 contracting arrangements where the appropriate administering entity submits documentation
8 to the Commissioner of Administration substantiating that it is in the best interest of the
9 citizens of the state, due to economic and/or operational benefits, and the necessity to
10 complete the projects in a timely manner; and, the appropriate administering entity shall
11 have the authority to directly appoint the design professional from a list of a minimum of
12 three design firms or joint ventures with the appropriate specialized facility design
13 experience submitted to and acceptable to the Commissioner of Administration and shall be
14 exempt from other state requirements for selection of designers, and may include
15 expenditures for computers, fixtures, furniture, and other equipment as such is deemed to
16 be capital outlay in nature, and unless the Commissioner of Administration is advised by
17 bond counsel to the State that such may violate federal tax law, may be used to reimburse
18 any expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit or the sale of bonds by the State
19 Bond Commission, determination by the State Treasurer that cash funding has been
20 deposited in the Comprehensive Capital Outlay Escrow Account for the project or the
21 execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement from the Office of Facility Planning and
22 Control, and may be used to acquire land or real property, the title to which is held in the
23 name of an entity exempt from taxation under the provisions of 26 U.S.C. 501(c)(3).

24 Section 8K. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay
25 Act to the contrary or any other provision of law, all of the funds herein appropriated to the
26 Department of Economic Development in connection with the Capital Improvements Project
27 to Meet Economic Development Commitments for which the Department of Economic
28 Development utilizes a cooperative endeavor agreement to further economic development
29 as permitted under Article VII, Section 14 of the Louisiana Constitution, including the
30 generation of tax revenues and creation of jobs, shall be considered as having been

1 appropriated to the Department of Economic Development, may be used to reimburse any
2 expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit and made prior to the execution of
3 a cooperative endeavor agreement and shall be administered solely by the Department of
4 Economic Development pursuant to, in compliance with, and on the terms contained in such
5 cooperative endeavor agreements.

6 Section 8L. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or the Capital Outlay
7 Act or any other provision of law to the contrary, all of the funds herein appropriated to the
8 Department of Economic Development in connection with projects or programs for which
9 the Department of Economic Development utilizes a cooperative endeavor agreement to
10 further economic development as permitted under Article VII, Section 14 of the Louisiana
11 Constitution, including the generation of tax revenues and creation of jobs, shall be
12 considered as having been appropriated to the Department of Economic Development, may
13 be used to reimburse any expenditure made prior to the granting of a line of credit and made
14 prior to the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement and shall be administered solely
15 by the Department of Economic Development pursuant to, in compliance with, and on the
16 terms contained in such cooperative endeavor agreements without compliance with any other
17 law, including, but not limited to, the provisions of R.S. 39:101 through 128. Additionally,
18 all expenditures of these appropriations may be exempted by the Commissioner of
19 Administration, from all statutes relative to public bidding, contractual review and the
20 provisions of R.S. 33:9029.2(D).

21 Section 8M.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act or the Capital
22 Outlay Act or any other provision of law to the contrary, funds appropriated for the
23 Economic Development Award Program project for the Office of Business Development
24 are to be used solely for capital and infrastructure improvements subject to verification by
25 the Division of Administration, Office of Facility Planning and Control.

26 (2) Eligible expenses for Economic Development Award Program funds may include
27 documented project expenses beginning on the date of LEDC Board approval of the project
28 and may be reimbursed upon execution of the cooperative endeavor agreement for the
29 project.

1 Section 8N. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the Commissioner
2 of Administration is hereby authorized to take such actions as are necessary, including using
3 such funds as may be available including those appropriated and available under this Act or
4 the Capital Outlay Act for professional sports facilities through the Louisiana Stadium and
5 Exposition District and that are otherwise available, executing on behalf of the State such
6 documents as are necessary in order to terminate the ground lease between the State and the
7 PGA and thereby acquiring all leasehold improvements for the State, extending the
8 management agreement between the State and the PGA, and extending the sponsorship and
9 presence of the Zurich Classic in the Greater New Orleans area.

10 Section O. Notwithstanding anything in this Act, any previous capital outlay act, or
11 other provision of law to the contrary, monies appropriated herein for the Port of South
12 Louisiana Globalplex Terminal Building #71 and Other Globalplex Terminal Building
13 Upgrades, Planning and Construction may be expended for design fees related to the
14 conveyor system and ancillary equipment that exceed the customary ten percent limitation
15 on design fee costs.

16 Section P. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary or any other
17 provision of law, monies appropriated herein for the Juban Road (LA1026) Widening (I-12
18 to US 190) project may be expended for the installation of sewer lines along the roadway
19 and pursuant to a cooperative endeavor agreement between the Department of
20 Transportation and Development and Livingston Parish, funds may be provided to
21 Livingston Parish for that purpose.

22 Section 8Q. The new University Medical Center in New Orleans project in Orleans
23 Parish shall be exempt from the state's requirements for selection of designers and the
24 Commissioner of Administration shall have the authority to approve a design professional
25 selection process. The design professional fee shall be in accordance with state guidelines
26 administered by the Office of Facility Planning and Control, Division of Administration.

27 Section 8R.(1) The Division of Administration, Office of Facility Planning and
28 Control, with approval of the Commissioner of Administration and the Joint Legislative
29 Committee on the Budget, is authorized to use alternative delivery strategies in
30 implementing hurricane damage repairs to Southern University at New Orleans, Hazardous

1 Material Abatement Projects, the City Park Golf Complex Improvements project, the
2 Health/Human Performance Education Complex, and the Patrick Taylor Hall Renovation
3 and Expansion project.

4 (2) In addition, with the approval of the Commissioner of Administration and the
5 Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget, an alternative delivery strategy may be used in
6 the implementation of the Louisiana Children's Museum, Early Learning Village project.

7 Section 8S.(1) Due to the State's current investment in TPC Louisiana and the
8 financial support it provides to the PGA TOUR event currently played at said facility, the
9 funding of the City Park Golf Complex Improvements project described above is
10 conditioned upon said PGA TOUR event not being played at New Orleans City Park Golf
11 Complex without the prior agreement of the Commissioner of Administration and the
12 Chairman of the Jefferson Parish Council.

13 (2) Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City Park Golf Complex may host any other
14 golf tournament or event, including but not limited to any other PGA-affiliated or sponsored
15 tournament or event.

16 Section 8T.(1) For all projects administered by the Office of Facility Planning and
17 Control and payable from proceeds of self-generated revenues, funds shall be remitted to the
18 Office of Facility Planning and Control for deposit in the state treasury at such time as may
19 be deemed necessary by the Office of Facility Planning and Control in order to cover the
20 amount of contracts or other project expenses.

21 (2) Notwithstanding any provisions contained herein or any other law to the contrary,
22 for projects with other means of financing provided to the administering agency by
23 interagency transfer, the authority to draw these funds shall remain with the user agency.

24 (3) Any revenue bonds appropriated in Section 1 of the Capital Outlay Act shall not
25 be secured by the full faith and credit of the state.

26 (4) The State Treasurer shall refund to the appropriate source any surplus self-
27 generated funds, advanced insurance funds received by the Office of Facility Planning and
28 Control as Interagency Transfer from Office of Risk Management associated with hurricane
29 damage recovery, and interest earned on these funds, provided the Treasurer's Office is

1 notified, when these funds are deposited in the state treasury, that the user agency or Office
2 of Risk Management intends to request a refund of this interest.

3 Section 8U.(1) Notwithstanding anything in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act to
4 the contrary or any other provision of law, contracts may be entered into for the Tulane
5 University Tulane River and Coastal Center Project prior to receipt of funding and prior to
6 the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement, and the project is exempted from all
7 statutes relative to public bidding and state procurement and in lieu thereof shall be subject
8 to federal government qualifications and regulations approved by the Economic
9 Development Authority.

10 (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act or the Capital Outlay Act or any
11 other provision of law to the contrary, contracts may be entered into for the City of Gretna's
12 Lion's Club Conversion to Senior Center project prior to receipt of funding and prior to
13 execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement and the project is exempted from all statutes
14 relative to public bidding and contractual review.

15 Section 8V. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act,
16 or any other provision of law to the contrary, the letting of a contract for construction of the
17 "Louisiana Construction Center", funded wholly by the Louisiana Licensing Board for
18 Contractors, shall be exempt from all statutes relative to public bidding and contractual
19 review.

20 Section 8W. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act,
21 or any other provision of law to the contrary, the Department of Transportation and
22 Development shall use \$2,500,000 of general obligation bond funding appropriated for
23 Department of Transportation and Development, Administration, Highway Program (Up to
24 \$4,000,000 for Secretary's Emergency Fund) in Act 25 of the 2014 Regular Session of the
25 Legislature for the Louisiana Highway 92 Overlay, Preservation and Construction
26 (Lafayette) project.

27 Section 8X. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, the Capital Outlay Act,
28 or any other provision of law to the contrary, \$50,000 of the appropriation for Department
29 of Natural Resources, Office of the Secretary, Atchafalaya Basin Protection and
30 Enhancement (Federal Match and Local/Sponsor Match)(Assumption, Avoyelles, Iberia,

1 Iberville, Pointe Coupee, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary) will be used to fund House
2 Concurrent Resolution No. 168 of 2011.

3 Section 9. Notwithstanding any provisions contained herein or any other law to the
4 contrary, the provisions of Chapter 16 of Subtitle III of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised
5 Statutes of 1950 as amended, shall not apply to architectural and engineering contracts,
6 administered by the office of facility planning and control, division of administration
7 pursuant to this or any other capital outlay act.

8 Section 10. All funds appropriated herein to the office of facility planning and
9 control, division of administration, on behalf of non-state entities, and administered by
10 cooperative endeavor agreements pursuant to this Act shall be expended within two (2) years
11 from the date of the issuance of the bonds. The office of facility planning and control,
12 division of administration, agrees that it will notify the non-state entity of the date the bonds
13 are issued within three (3) months from the issuance thereof. The non-state entity
14 understands and agrees that if the funds appropriated herein and administered under
15 cooperative endeavor agreements pursuant to this Act are not totally expended within two
16 (2) years from the issuance of the bonds, the office of facility planning and control, division
17 of administration, can close the project and recommend that the legislature reallocate any
18 unexpended proceeds to other projects.

19 Section 11. Notwithstanding any provisions contained herein or law to the contrary,
20 the proceeds of revenue bonds to be utilized to fund certain projects authorized in Section
21 1 hereof may, in accordance with Article VII, Section 9 of the Louisiana Constitution of
22 1974, be deposited in special accounts held outside the state treasury in accordance with the
23 provisions of any bond resolution, indenture, reimbursement contract, or other bond or
24 financing covenant which provides for the pledge of such funds in connection with the
25 issuance of revenue bonds. For all projects administered by the office of facility planning
26 and control, division of administration, authorized in Section 1 hereof which are payable
27 from the proceeds of revenue bonds, only the office of facility planning and control, division
28 of administration, will be authorized to requisition funds from the special accounts described
29 immediately above, at such time or times as may be deemed necessary by the office of

1 facility planning and control, division of administration, in order to cover contract amounts
2 or other project expenses.

3 Section 12. The governor shall have the power to veto any line-item in this Act.

4 Section 13. Except as otherwise provided herein, no funds shall be expended on any
5 highway projects on highways within the state highway system as established in R.S. 48:191
6 under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation and Development unless and until
7 such project is in the Highway Program, R.S. 48:228 through 232, approved by the Joint
8 Legislative Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works. Pursuant to R.S.
9 49:214.6.2(B), no integrated coastal protection construction project shall be undertaken with
10 funds included in this bill except those included in an annual plan finally approved by the
11 legislature in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 49:214.5.3. No funds appropriated to
12 the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority in this Act as a contribution for a project
13 cost-share or otherwise, for the national economic development and national ecosystem
14 restoration components of the Southwest Coastal Louisiana Study shall be used or provided
15 for the expropriation of property or use of eminent domain, except where such funds are to
16 be used to obtain property voluntarily offered for project purposes, where at least seventy-
17 five percent of the owners have voluntarily offered the property, or where the record or
18 apparent owners have voluntarily offered the property but do not have clear title.

19 Section 14. The word "statewide" used in place of the specific parish designation for
20 projects contained in this Act indicates that the project or program is applicable to all sixty-
21 four parishes in the state. The description of any project in this Act shall be deemed to
22 include planning, design, master planning, studies, permits, surveys, testing, construction,
23 land and/or building/improvement acquisition, reconstruction, renovation, repair, right of
24 way and utilities, site and other improvements, miscellaneous/contingencies, lease hold
25 improvements ultimately owned by the state or a political subdivision of the state, equipment
26 and other acquisitions, and any other component of the project if such are included or
27 indicated in the capital outlay request for such projects required by R. S. 39:101 subject to
28 the provisions of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes. For new construction or
29 renovation projects, equipment or other acquisitions, which can reasonably be considered
30 necessary for the facility to be functional, may be deemed to be included in the project, even

1 if such equipment or other acquisitions are not included or indicated in the project name or
2 the capital outlay request. When local or federal match is referenced in a project title, but
3 only a portion of the state appropriation is granted a line of credit or otherwise funded, then
4 the amount of local or federal match, required to be made available, may be prorated relative
5 to the amount of state appropriation made available through lines of credit.

6 Section 15. The provisions, items, and projects contained in this Act are severable
7 and if any provision, item, or project contained herein, or the application of any such
8 provision, item, or project, is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions,
9 items, projects, or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid
10 provision, project, item, or application.

11 Section 16. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the state
12 shall not grant cash lines of credit, or authorize or issue general obligation bonds in a
13 principal amount in excess of \$965,210,000 for Fiscal Year 2018-2019.

14 Section 17. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this Act or any contrary
15 provision of law, no funds appropriated by this Act shall be released or provided to any
16 recipient of an appropriation made in this Act if, when, and for as long as, the recipient fails
17 or refuses to comply with the provisions of R.S. 24:513. The legislative auditor is authorized
18 to grant an extension of time to comply with the provisions of R.S. 24:513 for recipient
19 entities of an appropriation contained in this Act. No recipient shall be considered to fail
20 or refuse to comply with the provisions of R.S. 24:513 pursuant to this Section during any
21 extension of time granted by the legislative auditor to the recipient to comply.

22 Section 18. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
23 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
24 by the governor, as provided in Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
25 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
26 effective on the day following such approval.
