CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: Adds certain substances to Schedule I and Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:964(Schedule II)(A)(1)(introductory paragraph) and to enact		
3	R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(A)(61) and (C)(64), relative to controlled dangerous		
4	substances; to provide relative to opiates and hallucinogenic substances; to provide		
5	for additional prohibited controlled dangerous substances; and to provide for related		
6	matters.		
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
8	Section 1. R.S. 40:964(Schedule II)(A)(1)(introductory paragraph) is hereby		
9	amended and reenacted and R.S. 40:964(Schedule I)(A)(61) and (C)(64) are hereby enacted		
10	to read as follows:		
11	§964. Composition of schedules		
12	Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V shall, unless and until added to pursuant to R.S.		
13	40:962, consist of the following drugs or other substances, by whatever official		
14	name, common or usual name, chemical name, or brand name designated:

16	A. Opiates. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule,		
17	any of the following opiates, including their isomers, esters, ethers, salts, or salts of		
18	isomers, esters, and ethers, whenever the existence of such isomers, esters, ethers,		
19	or salts is possible within the specific chemical designation:

15	A. Substances of vegetable origin or chemical synthesis. Unless specifically		
16	excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any of the following substances

18	origin, or independently by means of chemical synthesis, or by a combination of		
19	extraction and chemical synthesis:		
20	(1) Opium and opiate, and any salt, compound, isomer, derivative, or

Abstract: Adds Cyclopropylfentanyl and Deschloroketamine to Schedule I and naldemedine to Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits the possession of various controlled dangerous drugs or substances listed in Schedules I, II, III, IV, and V of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds Cyclopropylfentanyl and Deschloroketamine to Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds naldemedine to Schedule II of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law.
