13 (7) The chair of the House Committee on Natural Resources and Environment or
14 another member of the committee designated by the chair.

15 (8) The chair of the House Committee on the Judiciary or another member of the
16 committee designated by the chair.

17 (9) The chair of the House Committee on Commerce or another member of the
18 committee designated by the chair.

19 (10) The chair of the House Committee on Education or another member of the
20 committee designated by the chair.

21 (11) The secretary of the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, or his
22 designee.

23 (12) The secretary of the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, or his designee.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in conducting such study, the task force shall
2 study current law, policy, and efforts in Louisiana and other states to prevent the dumping
3 of litter and trash and to clean state highways and roads.

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the task force shall serve
5 without compensation, except per diem or expenses reimbursement to which they may be
6 individually entitled as members of the constituent organizations.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a majority of the total membership shall
8 constitute a quorum of the task force, and any official action taken by the task force shall
9 require an affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum present and voting.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force may conduct such meetings at
11 such times as it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and
12 effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this
13 Resolution.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall make a report of its findings
15 and recommendations, with suggestions for proposed legislation, if any, to the legislature
16 no later than sixty days prior to the convening of the 2019 Regular Session.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force shall terminate on March 1, 2019.
